## LONG TITLE

A Statute to provide for the rules by which representation of the Diocese of North West Australia shall be elected to the Provincial Council of Western Australia.

The Synod of the Diocese of North West Australia resolves as follows.

### Chapter 1 – Preliminary

#### NAME

This is the *Provincial Council Election Statute 1961*.

### Chapter 2 – Scope of the Statute

1. The Provincial Synod Election Statute 1982 is repealed in its entirety.
2. Immediately after the passing of this Statute and at each subsequent session of Synod two clerical and two lay representatives, being members of the Synod of the Diocese of North West Australia, shall be elected by the Synod as representatives of the Diocese of North West Australia in the Provincial Council of Western Australia.
3. Notice shall be sent to each representative before the Provincial Council meets and, if any representative shall be unable to attend he shall inform the Bishop who shall proceed to appoint an alternate.
4. All elected representatives respectively shall continue to hold their positions until their successors are elected.

## Chapter 3 – Regulations & Related Legislation

### REGULATIONS

#### Regulation making power

The Diocesan Council may from time to time make, amend or repeal regulations (e.g. policies and procedures) not inconsistent with the provisions of this Statute providing for records arising out of or incidental to the operation of this Statute and for all or any of the purposes, whether general or to meet particular cases, which may be convenient for the administration of this Ordinance or which may be necessary or expedient to carry out the overriding purposes of this Statute.

## Chapter 4 – General

### RESPONSIBILITIES

#### Review

The Diocesan Council will review the operation of this Statute on or before six years after its commencement.

#### Records management

The Registry maintains all records relevant to administering this Statute using its recordkeeping system.
